

RV Baby-Proofing & Toddler Safety Checklist

Here's a quick and practical checklist of the baby- and toddler-proofing solutions we've put in place in our Alliance Paradigm 340RL—as well as some challenges we're still working on. Perfect for other RV-living families looking to create a safer space for their little ones.

What We've Already Baby-Proofed

- Installed oven safety latches and knob covers
- Added child safety latch on under-sink cabinet (trash + cleaning supplies)
- Magnet blockers removed from easy-to-reach cabinets to keep them tightly sealed
- Baby gate installed at the stairs
- Sliding bathroom door now secured with a lock
- Dog food container moved away from crib to prevent climbing
- Full-size crib set up in place of kitchen table
- Mini crib placed in master bedroom with furniture rearranged to fit

What We're Still Working On

- Crib-to-toddler bed transition planning
- Securing RV front door from toddler unlocking attempts
- Preventing toddler escape from sleep sack (possibly wearing it backwards)
- Monitoring cabinet magnets for wear-and-tear over time
- Exploring toddler-proofed layout options (toy hauler vs bunk area conversion)
